1990 SHIRAZ

This wine is the first wine to be produced by Turkey Flat Vineyards. It was made at Wirra Wirra Winery in the McLaren Vale. The Fruit flavour and colour from these unique berries has been highlighted using French oak fermentation and maturation.

The vines which produced the grapes for this wine were planted in 1847, before the Ballarat gold rush, the American Civil War or the Russian Revolution – and not long after the City of Adelaide was settled. They are among the oldest Shiraz vines in the world.

As fourth generation Barossa grape growers it's a pleasure to offer this first estate grown wine from the Turkey Flat Vineyards. We know you will enjoy it now or in four or five years when you blow off the cellar dust.

The Wine

Harvested	– Early April
Bottled	– 17 July, 1992
Oak Treatment	– All barrel fermented in new barriques. Half French oak, and half American.
Colour	– Ruby Red
Nose	– Earthy, Peppery, and Blackberry
Palate	– Spicy, Stewed Plums and Blackcurrant
Cellar	– 6-8 years cellaring
Alcohol	– 12.5% alc/vol
