1991 SHIRAZ

This is our second Shiraz produced for Turkey Flat Vineyards, and was made at Basedow Winery in the Barossa Valley. The Fruit flavour and colour from these unique berries has been highlighted using French oak fermentation and maturation.

The vines which produced the grapes for this wine were planted in 1847, before the Ballarat gold rush, the American Civil War or the Russian Revolution – and not long after the City of Adelaide was settled. They are among the oldest Shiraz vines in the world.

As fourth generation Barossa grape growers it's a pleasure to offer this first estate grown wine from the Turkey Flat Vineyards. We know you will enjoy it now or in four or five years when you blow off the cellar dust.

The Wine

Harvested	– Mid March
Bottled	– June, 1993
Oak Treatment	– Seasoned French and American Oak Hogsheads
Colour	– Purple/Violet
Nose	– Peppery, Plum, and Savoury
Palate	– Blackcurrant, Spicy, and Earthy
Cellar	– 6 to 8 years cellaring
Alcohol	– 12.5% alc/vol
