1992 SHIRAZ

The sell-out 1990 Turkey Flat Shiraz was described by wine authority David Farmer as “distinctive, unique and very satisfying – a highly individual Barossa red”. We couldn’t agree more – it is our flagship wine and represents the special blending of grapes from 147 year old dry grown Shiraz vines, sweet American oak and time honoured Barossa winemaking skills.

The new release Shiraz has a dark brick red colour, a rich, full flavoured palate suggesting plums and mint and a tannin structure to make it last and last. This vintage was made at Rockford Winery using open fermenters and the basket press. The 1992 vintage was considered by many as a classic year. Buy it now for your new born’s 21<sup>st</sup> birthday celebration and you won’t be disappointed – or drink it next week with pheasant or jugged hare!

Bottled	– 5th July 1994
Oak Treatment	– All American Oak Seasoned Hogsheads
Colour	– Brick Red
Nose	– Peppery, Spicy, and Plums
Palate	– Plums, Mint and a well tannin structure
Cellar	– 10+ years
Alcohol	– 12.5% alc/vol
