1993 GRENACHE NOIR

This is the second release of the Grenache Noir that Turkey Flat Vineyards has produced. This wine was made at Rockford Winery in the Barossa Valley.

The 1993 Grenache Noir was described by *The Advertiser's* Philip White as a "slippery, seductive miracle – a major work".

The very old yielding bush vines, gravelly soil, and maturation in oak are the ingredients needed to produce a full bodied style such as this.

Turkey Flat Grenache Noir is a food wine, ideally suited to full flavoured dishes of all kinds.

*The Wine*

Harvested	– Late April
Bottled	– 22 <sup>nd</sup> December, 1993
Oak Treatment	– All seasoned in American Oak Hogsheads
Colour	– Ruby red
Nose	– White Pepper, Savoury
Palate	– Spicy, Licorice overtones
Cellar	– Up to 7 years
Alcohol	– 14.3% alc/vol
